My final tour was OP 940 & I retired on 1 July 1976.





I reported aboard Roberts in July, 1955 fresh out of the NROTC program at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. I requested "Destroyers, Atlantic," for small ship experience. I filled the billet of Division Officer for R Division and Damage Control Assistant. Within days the ship left port to take station near Iceland when President Eisenhower flew to Geneva to meet with Chairman Khrushchev. Next I got orders to the Damage Control school in Philadelphia while the ship was in the Boston Naval Shipyard. That prepared me for refresher training at GITMO. With that behind us we left for the Mediterranean to serve as plane guard for a Sixth Fleet carrier. We enjoyed liberty in Piraeus, Greece and Monaco before transiting the Suez Canal to join the Mideast Force at Bahrain. On the way we had a brief encounter with a sister ship that smashed our whaleboat. R Division boat-building skills restored the whaleboat. As a watch stander I qualified as Officer of the Deck Underway and late in 1956 I was promoted to LTJG. 
